# LYF Camp: A Summer Experience

Join us for a fun, enriching week-long summer camp that develops our community's youth into individuals and leaders, instilling in them a love of learning and personal growth.

## Introduction

LYF Camp is a week-long sleep away camp packed with leadership workshops, teamwork exercises, and endless summer fun. It's a mashup of Taiwanese culture and the classic American summer camp, filled with Taiwanese treats, songs and s'mores by the campfire, and many other fun activities that weave two cultures to create a unique experience. We primarily serve Taiwanese American youth from 5th grade to 12th grade, but we encourage anyone to join in on the fun.

The counselors and staff at LYF Camp create a safe environment for campers to explore, grow, and freely express themselves. We hope that through this experience our campers are able to open up and discover something new about themselves and the world around us, taking home insights into their daily lives.



## Camp Life

Campers are sorted by age into small groups of approximately 8 to 10. Led by counselors, the small group is a camper's family over the week of camp. The safe environment and the LYF Camp experience brings campers together and creates lifelong friendships.



## Programming

The core of LYF Camp revolves around four workshops. The workshops explore the different themes of what it means to be a Taiwanese American leader: leadership, identity, teamwork, and community. We teach our campers important life skills and encourage them to try new things, see new perspectives, and make an impact on our communities.

Clinics are activities designed to expand and nurture campers' interest in sports, science, art, culture, or performing arts. We have more than 40 different clinics, such as hip hop, a capella, mochi, ice cream making, taiwanese language, and more!
