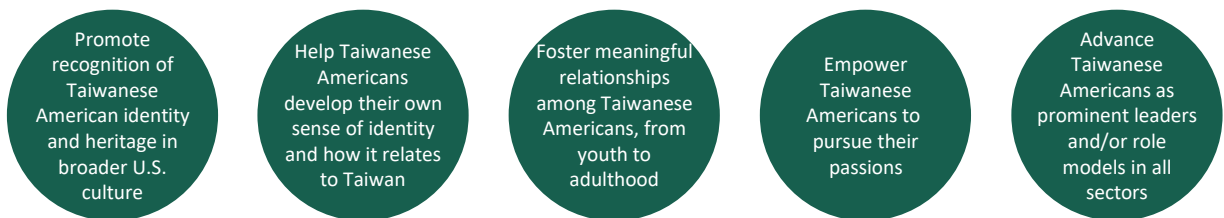


TACL at a glance: 2022

TACLEGACY FUND

The idea for the TACLegacy Fund was discussed late 2021 and formally brought into reality in 2022. The TACLegacy Fund is a donor-advised endowment fund in which TACL will eventually use to hire additional resources and staff in the future. This will ensure the future of TACL through sustainable means and will help expand programming.

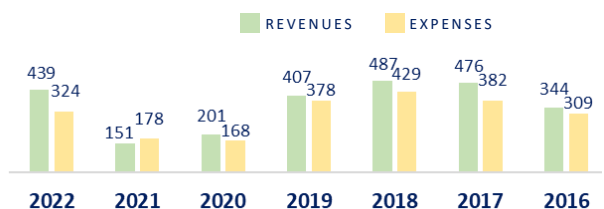
TACL NATIONAL CONVENTIONS FOCUS
